BREW AT THE ZOO: This was a great event in August that found 29 volunteers in support of Mom's Closet for the day (which may have been the biggest group of support of any there that day). MCRC received a 50 dollar donation for each volunteer along with some miscellaneous support. These efforts brought in over \$1500, and those that volunteered had a good time doing it as it was a fun event for most people (volunteers & participants alike) in attendance. This was an awesome response by our supporters to another fund raising opportunity for MCRC. Every little bit helps.

3RD MONDAY OF THE MONTH MEALS (OR MCRC RESTAURANT NIGHTS):



During the 3rd Q we had meals at Zaxby's, City BBQ and Panera Bread. When people attended the restaurant on the designated Monday, a percentage of their

Annie is now giving back to Mom's Closet by doing pro-bono work for other client moms when needed. Her emotional journey inspired the attendees to contribute over \$12,000. NEW MOMS



Due to some advances in fundraising and a decision to move forward in faith, new moms are being "on boarded" (at least 5) to the program, as we hope to get up to 18 by the end of the month and 20 by the end of the year. Additionally, this includes at least 18 children with 6 additional children of college age. We must keep in mind that not only are we helping out a single mom with our mission, we are also helping out their future generation. Our moms are pursuing jobs/degrees such as: Bachelors of Human Services & Counseling, Occupational Therapy, Bachelors in Arts, Bachelors in Social Work, Masters in Organized Leadership, Associates, Bachelors and RN in Nursing, Masters in HR. However, we have 20 or more moms on our wait list; thus the need is persistent.

HEARTWARMERS/SUCCESS STORIES

We are pleased to share a great story about one of our mom's getting her OTA (Occupational Therapy Assistant) application covered. She was unable to complete her first go around successfully and was at a loss as to what to do because she could not cover the cost of a second application. LOUISVILLE, KY – MOM'S CLOSET is proud to announce it received a grant from the Honorable Order Kentucky Colonels (HOKC) in the amount of \$3,719.00 to purchase 1065.5 lbs. of ground beef for our pantry which will be utilized by our mom's and their families.
