# **MOM'S CLOSET "FACTS IN A NUTSHELL"**

We have had 37 Life Plan graduates and 27% of those earned more than one degree.
Over 246 Moms have used the food pantry.

• 594 additional moms have been helped with resources and referrals to other beneficial organizations.

One mom graduated law school, is a practicing attorney and does pro-bono work for MCRC clients.
Mom # 2 graduated with an Associates Degree and now owns her own cabinetry business. In addition, her daughter graduated with a Bachelor's Degree and has applied for Grad School.

• A third mom recently graduated with her Master's Degree. She is working at Centerstone and just opened her own practice. As did Mom # 2, she currently has a son attending college.

 FOOD PANTRY: Any single mother in Kentucky can access the food pantry 4 times a year.
 LIFE PLAN: The main focus and thrust of MCRC. A single mother, working 20 hours a week and going to school at least half time can qualify for the Life Plan. Upon qualifying, they can utilize the pantry as often as needed, have access to all other resources MCRC has available and receive financial assistance tailored to their specific case, as needed. • BRIDGE PROGRAM: This

program allows for working with teen mothers who may be getting ready to go to college or just starting college. MCRC works with the local Teenage Parent Program (TAPP) schools to bridge these young women into the LIFE PLAN Program. We are also looking at expanding our Bridge program to other partnering ministries for single mom's coming out of difficult situations and trying to rebuild their lives.

• CAREER CENTER: MCRC will be working with the Kentucky Career Center in finding ways to assist single mothers, who are coming out of college or just needing to change their profession, to find a career path that financially supports themselves and their family.

## **BIG DONATION!**

Northeast Christian Church's congregation donated a whopping 425 bags of groceries for the pantry. This was over 3,300 items!
